To whom it may concern

In order to exchange one's American drivers' license for a Portuguese one, the Direcção Geral de Viação (DGV), the equivalent to a U.S. Department of Motor Vehicles, has advised the Embassy that one should obtain and present the following documents, subject to the payment of a 24 Euros fee:

- A.* *Abstract of Driving Record* from one's last U.S. State of residence, indicating that the drivers license issued by that State is an authentic and valid document. The document must show the validity of the drivers' license, date of issuance, license class, any suspension/revocations.
- B.* Driver's license issued by your last U.S. State of residence.
- C.* Presentation of your Passport (original and one photocopy).
- D.* Form 1403 which is available at the DGV office or may be downloaded from the following website:

- E.* Two colored pictures.
- F.* Medical certificate.
- G.* Resident card (temporary or permanent) issued by the Portuguese Immigration (SEF).
